More really important stuff:

1. You must have a **signed** medical form and FBC activities slip turned into Aaron to go.
 2. If you have not paid, please do so! (If you need a scholarship, see Aaron.)
 3. Limit your luggage to 2 pieces (you may also bring a small carry-on or backpack type bag...Space is limited) Remember – if you bring it, you carry it!!!!
 4. Check-in on Monday morning...Check-in will begin at 10:15 AM.
 5. Any medication must be turned in at check-in with our cabin nurse @ Check in!!!!
- If there are any special health concerns, you need to discuss them with the nurse before camp.
6. Emergency contact numbers will be available at the parent/camper meeting.
 7. **No** student will drive themselves to Falls Creek or arrive by any other means unless **written parental consent** is given to Aaron Myers in the office. Students need to ride buses with our group.
 8. Rules can be found in the student registration packets. Parents are responsible for making sure students are aware of the rules.

Falls Creek 2018 Points of Interest



- Each student will be assigned to a family group!
(Girls w/Girls- Boys w/Boys)
- Family groups will meet together Monday evening, each day after our in-cabin study, and after evening devotionals before bed. This will be a time of reflection and discussion of events of the day/week, the student's lives in general, questions, prayer requests, praises, or decisions made at camp (a time of open and honest discussion and encouragement...you get the picture.)
- We will travel in a group to the services well in advance of each service. We will sit together all the time! Times for the services, when to meet, and other scheduling issues will be posted on the wall and on your name tag. We will operate on a 3 strikes and you're out policy. If you are late three times you go home. If you skip a service, unless medically necessary per our cabin nurse, punishment will be more swift.
- Each group will have KP and dorm duty.
- Schedule is busy...**Rest is important...Lights out has a purpose!**
- Students listen to your sponsor and other adult leadership...Mutual respect
- You are not required to participate in every recreational activity, but you will be required to be involved in at least one of the many provided.

Falls Creek 2018 - Rules



- 1 **No alcohol, or tobacco, or drugs allowed...**immediate trip home
- 2 **Meeting times are not negotiable. Follow schedule for *all* activities and obey cabin curfew.**
- 3 **Stealing and violence will not be tolerated!** A free trip home at your parents' expense.
- 4 **No practical jokes! Don't even think about it! (You will be sent home period.)**
- 5 **Cell phones will be checked in and checked out for use... they must not be carried around and used. If you don't need your phone don't bring it.**
- 6 **No profanity or cruel language.**
- 7 **No PDA in cabins or on grounds either.. Ask God to purify your *motives*.**
- 8 **Abide by the dress code! No arguments. The dress code exists for your safety.**

DRESS CODE

While we understand the desire for fashionable attire, we require you to wear modest clothing. Modesty is a biblical principle and helps keep people focused on the important things at camp. (1 Timothy 2:9-10; 4:12)

All apparel judgments will be left to the discretion of the Falls Creek Staff (FCS). If FCS determines a camper or campers should change their clothing to fall in line with camp requirements, then said camper or campers are required to do so.

GENERAL DRESS CODE GUIDELINES:

- **Shoes must be worn at all times outside of your cabin.**
- **Apparel may not display or promote tobacco, alcohol, controlled substances, or inappropriate language or pictures.**
- **Under garments must always be covered by outer garments (i.e. No boxer shorts hanging out or bra straps showing).**

- **Midriffs should always be covered.**
 - **No spaghetti strap shirts or dresses.**
 - **No tank tops.**
 - **No short shorts. At a minimum, shorts must extend to, or just beyond, the campers' finger tips.**
 - **No tight fitting and revealing clothing. This includes leggings or similar attire, which cannot be worn as pants.**
 - **Girls may wear dresses/skirts, but they must reach the top of the knee.**
 - **SWIMMING:**
 - Girls should wear modest one-piece swim suits. Males should not wear tight fitting swim suits.
- » While going to and from the swimming areas, all campers must wear shoes; males must wear a t-shirt and females must wear a long covering over their swim suits

What to Bring

Bible/Pen/pencil & Paper
 Clothes: Casual...finger-tip length shorts
 Long pants or dresses (must fit in dress code) for evening worship services if desired
 Recreation clothes
 Swim Suit (if you have a two piece you must wear a dark t-shirt over it)
 Sunscreen, beach towel, wet clothes bag
 Life jacket (if you have one)
 Shower Items/Toiletries (soap, shampoo, toothpaste/brush, etc...)
 Deodorant/ Antiperspirant
 Sheets & Blanket (or sleeping bag)...bed stuff-pillow/lovey
 Towels & washcloths (2 probably)
 Medication (any prescription medication will be turned in to our cabin nurse who will distribute it at the proper times)

What not to bring

Questionable clothing items (length, tightness, message, etc...)
 Expensive accessories (sun-glasses, jewelry, etc... take at your discretion)
 Practical joke items, Watergun, fireworks
 Knives of any size (pocket included)
 CD Players or CD's, MP3 Players, Ipods, etc...
 Tape players, Radios, Music, Other electronic equipment...
 Tablets, Nook, Kindle, PERSONAL DVD players, etc...
 Drugs, Alcohol, Tobacco
